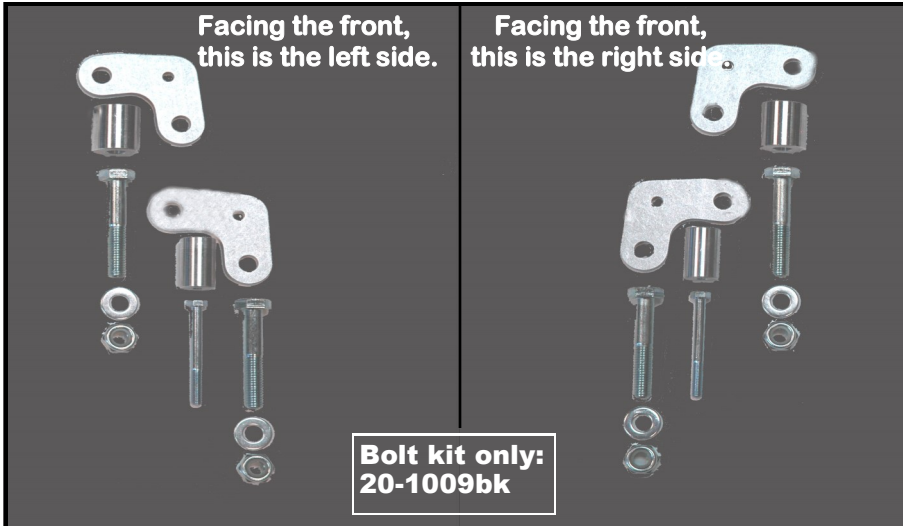


Yamaha YFZ 450 Front Lowering Kit

Part Number 20-1009



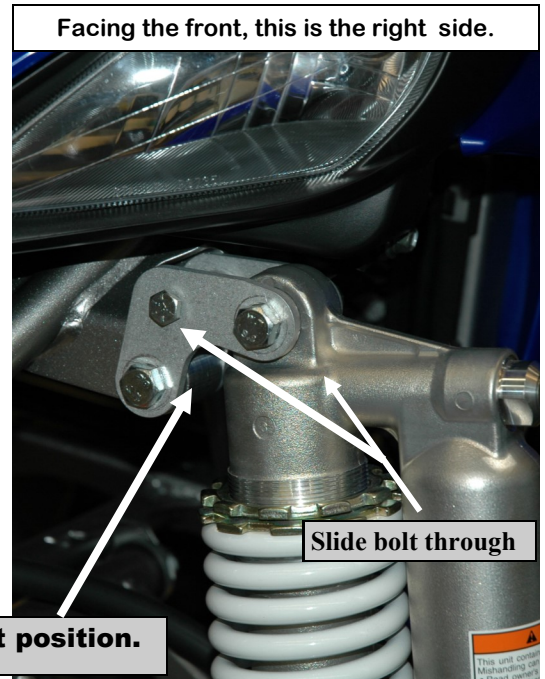
Note: Make sure you have received a complete kit. The picture (top left) shows all the parts and how they go together.

1) Raise the front end of the quad so the front wheels are off the ground.



2) Remove the upper shock bolt and swing the shock away from mounting bracket.

3) Install the kit onto the original shock mounting brackets. It may be necessary to trim some parts slightly due to variations of the mounting bracket.



4) Bring the shock over to the new shock position and install the cross bolt.
5) Repeat the same process on the other side. 6) Tighten all bolts and lower the ATV. Note: Be sure to check suspension for proper action. Ensure ATV has proper turn radius, and that no parts on the lowering kit are interfering with the a-arm or the shock on either side.

This is how your lowering kit should look when you're done! ► Bounce front up & down, check for binding!
